 - (ii) Part II: Part II is confined to Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) consisting of 90 compulsory questions from seven subjects (History, Geography, Civics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics).
- 7. Time for Part I is 90 minutes and for Part II is 90 minutes.
- 8. Each question carries 1 (one) mark.
- 9. Write your Roll Number, as given in the Admit Card, on the OMR Answer Sheet and on the cover page of the Question Booklet in the space provided.
- 10. DO NOT write your name in any part of the Question Booklet or the OMR Answer Sheet.
